The Hon. Michael Egan was appointed Chairman of TERRiA in May 2008. Based in Sydney, Egan is responsible for leading TERRiA – a consortium of major infrastructure based telecommunications companies, as it bids for the Federal Government’s National Broadband Network contract.

In addition to his TERRiA role, Egan currently holds the following positions: Chancellor of Macquarie University, Chairman of the Centenary Institute of Cancer Medicine & Cell Biology, Chairman of the Australia Day Council of New South Wales, Governor of the Woolcock Institute of Medical Research, Director of Ruebael Pty Ltd and Director of State Super Financial Services Pty Ltd.

Egan has more than 30 years experience within the government sector. He was Treasurer of New South Wales from 1995 to 2005, making him the State’s longest serving Treasurer since the introduction of responsible government in 1856.

During his time as Treasurer, Egan led the reform of the NSW electricity industry.

He has also held positions as the NSW Minister for State Development, NSW Minister for Energy, the Minister Assisting the NSW Premier and Acting Premier of NSW.

A Fellow of the Australian Institute of Company Directors, Egan holds a BA from Sydney University.
