Guy Debelle is the Assistant Governor (Financial Markets) at the Reserve Bank of Australia, a position he has held since March 2007.

He joined the Reserve Bank in 1994 and prior to his current position, worked in the Economic Research and Economic Analysis Departments including as Head of that Department and as Head of International Department. He has also worked at the International Monetary Fund, Bank for International Settlements, Australian Treasury and as a visiting professor in economics at the Massachusetts Institute of Technology.

He graduated from the University of Adelaide with an honours degree in economics, and gained his PhD in economics at MIT. He is an associate editor of the International Journal of Central Banking and has published on a range of topics in the fields of labour and monetary economics.
