Jeff Oughton is Nab's Head of Australian Economics & Industry Intelligence. His role covers monitoring and forecasting economic and financial conditions; and assessing industry opportunities and risks for the Group and its customers in Australia, New Zealand and the UK. He is also an expert on competition and supervision of financial systems.

Prior to his joining the National in 1992, Jeff spent over ten years with the Reserve Bank of Australia, working in both economic analysis and financial markets. This included over two years as the Reserve Bank Deputy Chief Representative in New York, involved in day-to-day management of Australia's US dollar reserves and oversight of Reserve Bank foreign exchange activities in that time zone. Jeff was CEO of the Australian Bankers' Association seconded from the National during 2000/2001 to conduct a strategic review of its activities.

He received a Bachelor of Economics (Honours) from Newcastle University and obtained a MBA from the Australian Graduate School of Management in 1986. He has lectured in economics and finance for the Securities Institute of Australia and is also a past council member of the Victorian Branch of the Economics Society of Australia.
