As managing director for Europe, Philippe Tromp has overall responsibility for FSA's marketing and underwriting activities in the asset-backed, municipal and public infrastructure markets of the United Kingdom and Continental Europe, as well as Australia and New Zealand. He is a member of FSA's Management Committee.

Under his leadership, FSA became a leading guarantor of European infrastructure financings, such as those issued under the U.K. Private Finance Initiative (PFI), and contributed to the development of funded and synthetic asset-backed markets in Europe, where FSA remains an important and innovative participant.

Prior to joining FSA in 1994, Philippe spent three years at Bankers Trust Company in London, where he was managing director of the asset finance group. Before that he was a principal and founding member of The Transportation Group Ltd, a financial services firm affiliated with Paine Webber Incorporated. Earlier, he was a vice president of Paine Webber Incorporated and a financial attaché to the French Treasury in New York.

Since December 2005, Philippe has served as Chairman of The European Securitisation Forum (ESF), an international trade association representing securities firms and banks that underwrite, trade and sell debt securities and other financial products globally.

He is a graduate of Ecole Nationale Supérieure des Mines and holds an MBA in finance and marketing from Columbia University.
